**Early Registration process for Current WMA Student to reserve for your child a spot in their classroom:** Account must be paid in full or arrangements made with the Business Office prior to re-enrollment (including Registration, Tuition, After School Care, and other additional fees.)

**Tuition and Registration Fee:** Fees will be divided over a 10-month period from August through May, meaning, 10% of Annual Tuition & 10% of Registration is due by 8/4/2020; then, beginning in September and for each following month of the school year, the next 10% is due by the monthly due date.

**Late Registration Fee:** A \$50 fee per child will be added to your Registration fee after 8/4/2020.

**Grants/Scholarships:** Available from certain local SDA churches, WMA, Step Up For Students (including Gardiner) FES, McKay, and AAA. Families should check with their church pastor or treasurer.

- **Multiple Students:** If families with multiple students have one or more students enrolled in grades 7-8 at WMA, then their grade 7-8 students will each receive a \$200 discount for the school year; if families with multiple students have one or more students enrolled in grades 9-12 at WMA, then their grade 9-12 students will each receive a \$400 discount for the school year.

**Advance Payment Tuition Discount:** A 2% discount is offered when a semester is paid in advance. When a year is paid in advance a 3% discount is offered.

**WMA Late Payment Fee:** A \$25 fee will be applied each month to accounts which are over 30 days late. Separate late payment fees may be applied to third party billing. Additionally, if any amount of a school bill is 90 days past due, as of December 31 of that year, including any unsigned scholarship check older than 15 days, that amount can be recorded on an IRS form 1099 from WMA in the responsible party's name for income reporting and income tax purposes.

**Payment Methods:** Cash, checks, and debit or credit cards. You may also have your bank send a check easily and automatically each month by setting up a recurring payment to Walker Memorial Academy, 1525 W. Avon Blvd., Avon Park, FL 33825 on their website. You may also pay via www.wmaeagles.org
